COIC is a regional “Council of Governments” under Oregon Revised Statutes section 190, with a Board of Directors of 11 elected officials from the city and county governments of Central Oregon, along with Tribal and other appointed representatives. COIC was created in the early 1970’s as a venue for regional planning, collaboration, priority-setting and service delivery. COIC’s current work force exceeds 130 staff members, with 12 office locations across seven cities and five counties. Primary program areas are Community and Economic Development, Business Loans, Employment and Training (including education), and Transportation.

#### **POSITION: Senior Transportation Planner**

This recruitment will remain open until the position is filled, with an initial application review date of March 9, 2018 at 12:00 p.m.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** The Senior Transit Planner is responsible for managing the planning program for the Cascades East Transit (CET) system, including operational planning and long term planning, for the purpose of ensuring orderly, strategic and cost-effective development of the Bend urban and regional public transit system.

Lead staff for engaging with partner city and county governments regarding planning issues and coordination; serve as CET representative on committees and work groups as assigned. Manages CET data and reports on CET performance, costs and other quality assurance and efficiency metrics. As a member of the CET leadership team, works closely with CET outreach and engagement team, community development staff, CET operations staff, and the Executive Director. Works under the direct supervision of the Transportation Manager.

Primary responsibilities listed below are not intended to be an exhaustive list of all responsibilities, duties and skills. They are intended to be accurate summaries of what the job classification involves and what is required to perform it.

**MINIMUM EDUCATION & QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree plus five (5) years of work experience in related field or the equivalent combination of education and experience in related field may be substituted.

**COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS:** The starting annual salary range for this position is \$55,560 - \$58,944.

- Low deductible Health Insurance includes dental and vision coverage for employee and dependents. Full time employees pay 10% of the total monthly premium.
- Life, Personal Accident and Long Term Disability Insurance – 100% employer paid
- Deschutes On-Site Medical Clinic and Pharmacy (free and discounted services to employees and dependents).

- PERS retirement - In addition to the “employer” contribution, COIC also makes the “employee” member contribution of 6% of salary.

- Aflac supplemental insurance – various plans are available
- Vacation leave – 8 hours per month to start, with increasing accruals over time, sick leave – 8 hours per month, plus 9 paid holidays
